### A.4 Basic information

Dear biathlon friends, we are sure there is no necessary to introduce our venue. However very shortly basic essential information only, in case you need more, find please our web [www.biathlonnmn.cz](http://www.biathlonnmn.cz) for additional details.

Nové Město Ski and Biathlon Stadium is situated 2 km from the city center. The stadium, the shooting range and the penalty loop lies at the altitude of 625 m.

The tracks at the width between 6 and 10 m lead in mixed pine-tree forest and are prepared using artificial snow from the beginning of December. The highest point of the tracks is 668 m high, the lowest is 611 m.

The average temperature in January is - 4 ° C, the average snow coverage in this time is 0.4 meter.

NMNM area was evaluated by awarding IBU A License in November 2007; shooting range is equipped with 30 HoRa electronic targets.

#### Via Prague

- in Prague follow green line II. (transit), then direction to Brno (motorway D1), use exit 119 V. Beranov (km 119) - direction to Ždár nad Sázavou (road 353) - then to Nové Město na Moravě, Hotel SKI, Biathlon Area

#### Via Brno

- D1 direction to Prague - exit 162 Velká Bíteš, then road 37 to Ždár nad Sázavou - then to Nové Město na Moravě, Hotel SKI, Biathlon Area
- or exit 141 Velké Meziříčí west - then direction to Ždár nad Sázavou (road 354) - then to Nové Město na Moravě, Hotel SKI, Biathlon Area

## A.8 Insurance

The organizers cannot be held liable for any damages caused to persons or material/ equipment. All participants must be covered by sufficient health, accident and liability insurances. By submitting the entry by names the National Federation confirms that all persons entered are covered by such insurance (in accordance with 1.5.2.b, IBU Event and Competition Rules).

## A.9 Arms and ammunition import, radio equipment

The participants of the EC being citizens of the EU member countries owning European gun license where the rifles are put down, have to present their European gun license and official organizer's invitation for the event when crossing the border of the Czech Republic.

The participants outside EU have to present Fire-arm accompanying letter, which is to be arranged with Consulate of the Czech Republic in their home country, see below and [www.mzv.cz](http://www.mzv.cz)

The import permission must be confirmed at the Embassy or Consulate of the Czech Republic. The import of rifles and ammunitions is free of charge on the basis of these documents – Invitation letter and Competition Invitation. When crossing the border the individual teams are asked to present the official Invitation.

### Rifle transport during event

The transport of the rifles from place of accommodation to the stadium and back has to be carried out with open breech-block. The rifles and ammunition are to be stored in the competitors' rooms. The breech-blocks and ammunitions have to be stored in a case /wardrobe/ or in a suitcase.

## B. Logistics

### B.1 Transports

#### Arrival by plane

The Organizing Committee is able to ensure transport of the teams and the entitled persons from the Prague or Vienna Airport to Nové Město and back, EUR 200 for minivan (microbus, 6 people) or EUR 400 by bus (minimum 20 people)

#### Arrival by train

The Organizing Committee ensures transport of the teams and the entitled persons:

- from the Prague Central Rail station to Nové Město and back, EUR 200 for minivan (microbus, 6 people) or EUR 400 by bus (minimum 20 people)
- from the Brno Central Rail station to Nové Město and back, EUR 100 for minivan

The local transport in NMNM during competition as requested, to the competition area and back, on the shuttle buses or minivans is free of charge, details are to be discussed personally

#### Notice!

Notice is hereby given: when entering the Czech Republic by car it is necessary (duty) to buy the highway label for each car (1-month/13 EUR or 1-week/ 9 EUR)

### B.2 Accommodation

The full board accommodation for all participants is organized at local hotels. Accommodation is situated maximum 12 km from the competition stadium.

**The hotel offer, the accommodation charges, full board plus soft drinks, per person and day:**

**Booking of the accommodation will only be done through the accommodation office only, in the order of incoming requests – see E:2**

The hotel payment habits:

The accommodation and staying costs can be paid by credit cards; in this case the payment is increased by the extra charge of 3% above the total sum paid in some hotels.

The required number of rooms must be requested when submitting the entry by numbers and is considered being booked when the entry by names is made.

**Any accommodation that is not used or returned with the entry by names must be paid by the respective national federations. Earlier departures cannot be considered.**
